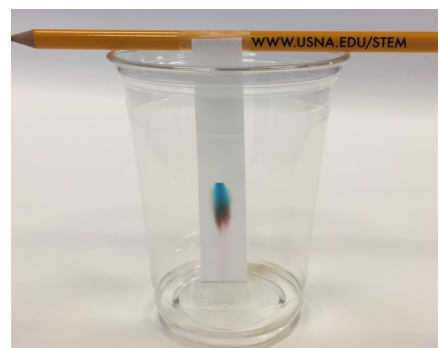
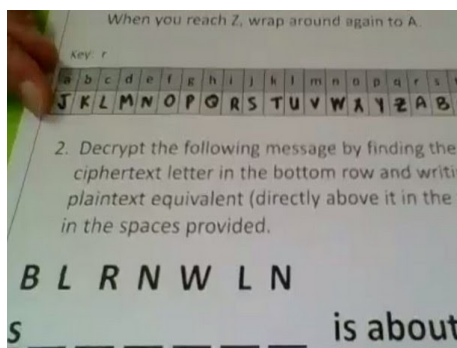
STEM Educator Training in Project-Based Learning
